Tips for Families on Reading Together

- 1. Just 15 minutes of reading together each day can spark a lifetime love of learning! Create a special reading routine that your child can look forward to. #RaisingaReader #FamilyReading #ReadTogether
- 2. Let your child pick the book tonight! Giving children a choice builds excitement and encourages a love of stories. #ReadTogether #RARAffiliate #RaisingaReader #FamilyReading
- 3. Don't worry about reading every word!

- **6.** Children love hearing stories over and over and that's great for their brains! Repetition strengthens language connections and confidence. RaisingaReader FamilyReading #ReadTogether
- **7.** Busy day? Reading doesn't have to be at bedtime! Try story time after breakfast, in the car, or while waiting at an appointment. #RaisingaReader #FamilyReading #ReadTogether
- 8. Use silly voices for characters! Changing your voice keeps reading fun and helps children follow the story. Bonus points for giggles! #RaisingaReader #FamilyReading #ReadTogether #StoryTimeFun
- **9.** Show your child that reading is important let them catch you with a book!
